 - 3. The program director (Lena Hileman) reported that Botany 2019 will have a total of 18 posters and 28 contributed papers from the Development and Structure Section. Of these 14 posters and 14 papers are anatomy and morphology and 4 posters and 14 papers are EvoDevo. We sponsored two symposia: "Life without water: evolution and adaptation of xeric plants," and "The evolution of functional traits in plants: is the giant still sleeping?"
- 4. The financial shape of the section is consistent with the previous year, which is sound (reporting covering Oct 1 2017-Sep 30 2018). Membership decreased to 228 current members, down from 243 in the previous year. At the end of the 2017-2018 financial year, we had a sectional cash balance of \$13,920.
